PROGRAMS AND RESOURCES

- BUILD Basics is our core eight-week business and project planning class designed for aspiring and established entrepreneurs. Classes are taught by local experts and cover all the basics of starting a business from licensing to financial literacy, market research to cash flow and more. You'll leave the class with a completed business plan, a cohort of fellow entrepreneurs in Detroit, and the knowledge and confidence to take your idea to the next level.
- Co.Starters is a 10-week business development program designed for aspiring entrepreneurs to put ideas into action and turn a passion into a sustainable and thriving small business. During Co.Starters, you'll develop and fine-tune your business idea, building models based on your assumptions, tweaking your next steps through real-time customer feedback, learning valuable management and marketing skills and receiving constructive feedback from advisers, peers and local businesses.

Eastern Market Partnership's mission is to manage operations, develop programs, build facilities, and provide critical infrastructure to:

- · Make Detroit happier by strengthening the Eastern Market District as a great place.

- Make Detroit healthier by increasing the consumption of healthy, green, affordable, and fair food.

PROGRAMS AND RESOURCES

- ServSafe Food Safety Manager Certification:
 ServSafe is a food and beverage safety training and
 certificate program for anyone working in the food
 industry. The ServSafe Manager Certification is a
 five-year certification and verifies that a manager or
 person-in-charge has sufficient food safety knowledge
 to protect the public from foodborne illness. Cost:
 \$165/person. This course is offered monthly.
- Food Business Licensing 101 Workshop: Become licensed through the Michigan Dept of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD), Wayne County, and the city of Detroit. Learn about health department regulations, kitchen etiquette, standard operating procedures, best practices, and food safety protocols.
- Essential Ingredients for Starting a Food Business:
 A six-week workshop series designed to provide the fundamentals and strong foundation for a consumer-packaged goods or foodservice-based business.

- Accelerating Your Food Business: A six-week workshop series designed to provide in-depth insights into the unique challenges and strategies involved in scaling a consumer-packaged goods foodservice-based business.
- Ask An Expert: Ask an Expert sessions are 25-minute virtual meetings that offer food entrepreneurs the opportunity to connect directly with seasoned professionals from our team of food industry experts.
- Drop-In Workshop Series: This six-week program
 offers a unique opportunity to "drop in" to any classes
 that pique your interest. Whether you are a seasoned
 entrepreneur or just starting your food business journey,
 these workshops offer a wealth of knowledge and
 practical techniques that you can immediately
 implement in your business.
